
The Wildlife Preservation Society -Dehradun Activities from Jan 2019 to Dec 2019

The Wildlife Preservation Society organized a number of activities and meetings from Jan -2019 to Dec 2019







On 17th February 2019, two activities were organized with the help of Uttarkhand Forest Department: A Nature Trail in Timli forest reserve and Bird watching camp at Asan Barrage. Two traveler buses were organized for the members. It was a bright sunny day and the buses left at 10 am and reached Timli FRH at 11 am. Mr Rashmi Kant Shukla, IFS (R) President introduced Mr. Pandey ACF. Mr. Pandey welcomed the members with Tea and snacks and took the members for the nature trail. The members returned to the FRH for lunch. After lunch members proceeded for Asan wetlands. Binoculars were distributed to the members to observe the wetland birds. A Forest Guard explained that Asan barrage was declared wetland conservation area in

2005 and inaugurated by late President Abdul Kalam. Most of the migratory birds come in November and leave by end of March. They come for feeding and not for nesting. Members observed Great Cormorant, common Moorhen, northern Pintail, pond Heron, Ruddy Shelduck, Bar-headed geese, Red-crested pochard, common Coot, etc.

21 APRIL 2019 Butterfly Trail at Jhajhara Forest Rest House





On 21st April 2019 a butterfly Nature trail was held at Jhajhara Forest Rest House. Mr Raj Shekhar Singh the walk leader addressed the gathering and gave a briefing on the morning's activity. Thereafter everyone proceed for a 'Walk in the Woods' with participants spotting, identifying and photographing different species of butterflies. Almost 25 different species of butterflies were spotted during the morning walk through the range over a period of two and a half hours. He also gave tips on how to make our homes more butterfly friendly and what plants should be added to our gardens to attract there colorful jewels of nature.
